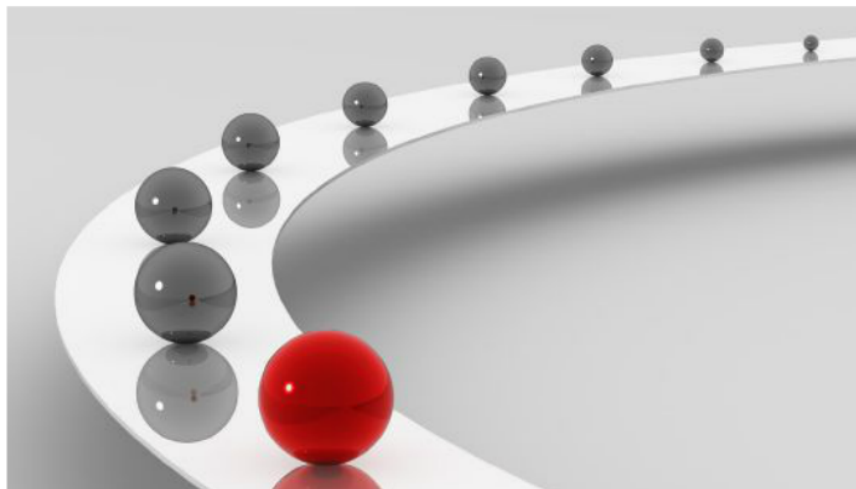

**M**otwani heads Miami Worldcenter, one of the largest real estate developments underway in the U.S. Phase one of the 27-acre mixed-use project will include
